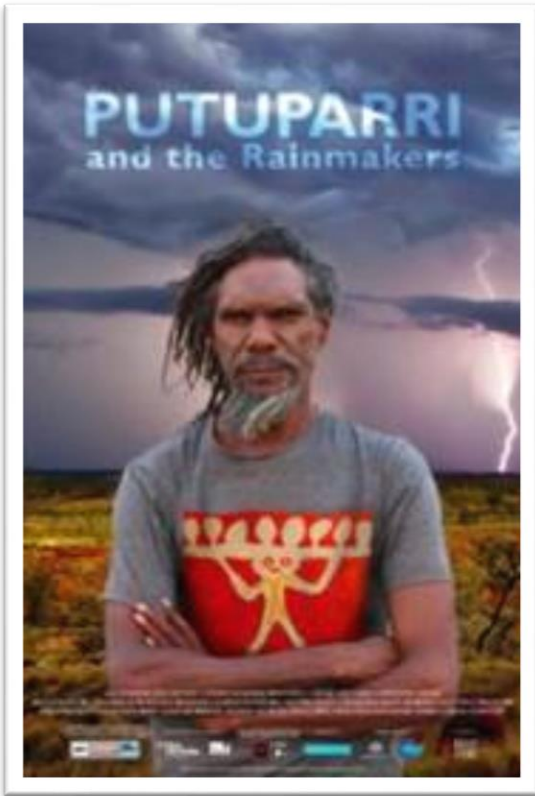


SCHOOL FACEBOOK PAGE

Science in the sandpit with Mr B

The children made a slide in the sand using a PVC pipe, a mound of sand and water. Using play, the children investigated which objects would go down the slide. They demonstrated persistence when looking for objects that could fit down the slide as some things were too big. After the children made the bears have a number of trips down the slide they reflected with Mr B on why the bears went down the slide. The children decided it was because the bears came to the top when the water was poured in. Mr B labelled this as floating. When it was suggested that they find other objects to test the children rushed off to find things. The wooden block floated and the treasure rock didn't.
