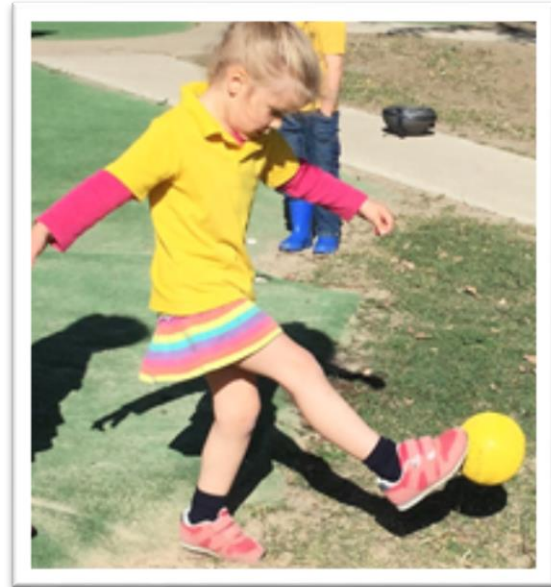

PRESCHOOL NEWS....

Each morning we have a check in, and at the end of each day we have check out. Children are beginning to identify and verbalise their emotions.

We warm up and do Munch and Move. This week we were leaping and kicking. We then wash our hands, eat our fruit and drink water.



Next is indoor and outdoor play. This is when children pursue individual projects and/or play. Educators spend time working with individuals or small groups of children on topics from planning or interests. One interest from planning was signs for the bike track.





Journal writing is in small groups. On Monday, children draw and talk about what they would like to do for the week. On Thursday, children respond to the cooking experience.

At 11:00 we have lunch together. Educators sit with the children during meal times encouraging children to eat in order of most healthy to least healthy food, discussing the reasons why certain foods are healthier and why it's important to eat healthy food. Children have been using the Australian Guide to Healthy Eating to look for the food in their lunch box and talk to each other about healthy foods. Some children can identify the next most healthy food choice and are showing an increasing awareness of good nutrition.



Aboriginal Education is after lunch. This week Mr B and the children listened to traditional Aboriginal music identifying the instruments and sounds used. They then made a niibi (snake) and danced to the music. This term we have also been learning body parts.

In the afternoon we have relaxation. This is a meditation story or yoga. We then move to small group rotation activities. This week we are playing cookie number match which is focusing on numerals and quantities. In the literacy group we are focusing on describing words, and the big floor puzzle activity focuses on collaboration, problem solving, fine motor skills and patience.

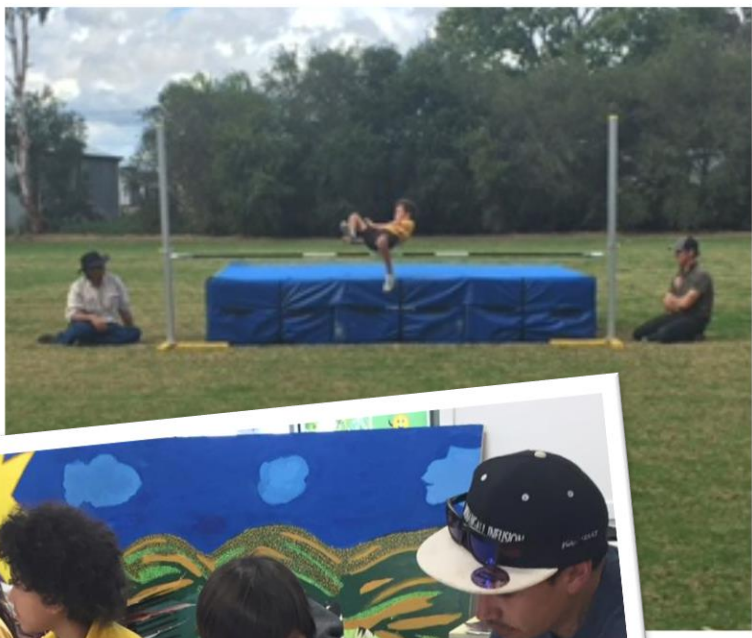

NSW SCHOOL VACCINATION PROGRAM 2016

School vaccination clinics continue into terms 3 & 4

The last vaccination day at Boggabilla Central School will be the 2nd November, 2016.

WHAT IF MY CHILD HAS MISSED A VACCINE?

If your child has missed any vaccinations they will be offered any missed doses at the next clinic at their school.

WHAT IF MY CHILD HAS NOT RECEIVED ALL HPV VACCINES BEFORE THE END OF 2016.

Any year 7 student with missed doses of HPV vaccine can be caught up in 2017.

Additionally – any year 8 student who commenced HPV vaccination while in year 7 and are yet to finish all 3 doses of HPV (and who has not received any from their local doctor) can still receive these at the next clinic at their school.

Don't forget a Record of Vaccination is given to each student for each vaccination. Parents/guardians should ensure that this record is kept for future reference and should not assume that their child has been vaccinated if they do not receive this Record of Vaccination.
